October 21st Introduction to Eschatology: **Key passages:** Acts 1:6-11; Matt. 28:18-20
High view of Scriptures: Infallibility plenary inspiration (2 P.1:20, 21) functional inerrancy.
(when people disagree with you, they defame your character and doubt your belief in the Bible, rather than answer or open a dialogue about your challenges).

Theme verses: Acts 17:11; 2 Tim. 2:15; 2 Corin. 2:17 and I Corin. 4:6 (with Deut. 4:2; 12:32; Prov. 30:5, 6; Jer. 23: 28, 29).

(Matthew 24:9)

November 4th Seven Signs: Number Two: Worldwide Iniquity
(Matthew 24:12)

November 11th Seven Signs: Number Three: Worldwide Apostasy (Days of Noah)
(Matt. 24:37) (2Thess. 2:3)

November 18th Seven Signs: Number Four: Worldwide sharing of the Gospel
(Matthew 24:14)

November 25th Seven Signs: Number Five: Worldwide Antichrist
(2 Thess. 2:5-12)

December 2nd Seven Signs: Number Six: Jerusalem No Longer Trodden Underfoot
(Luke 21:24)

December 9th Seven Signs: Number Seven: All Israel Grafted Back Into the Holy Olive Tree
(Romans 11:25, 26)

The absence of passages from the Revelation indicates that it reveals the clockwork of G-d's purposes, while Israel remains G-d's time piece. The Revelation makes more use of OT material than any other book in the NT (between 200-600).
