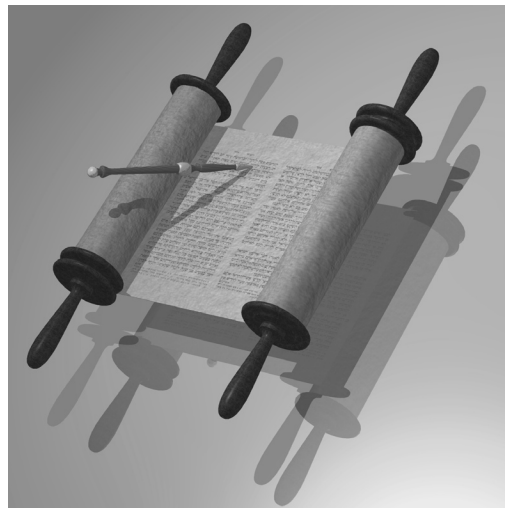

About the Instructor



Aaron Eime is a Bible Historian and the Deacon of Christ Church, Jerusalem. Aaron is an accomplished Bible Teacher specializing in the Hebraic Roots of the Christian Faith. Aaron studied in the Masters program at the Rothberg School, Hebrew University in Jerusalem. The focus of his studies centered on Early Jewish and Christian Interpretation of Bible. Aaron has lived in Israel for the past 20 years and taught internationally in Europe, Asia and North America. He has presented for the Watchman series on TBN. When not teaching or studying with local Rabbis, Aaron spends time with his wife and three children whom are home-schooled. Currently Aaron is working on writing and producing material for an Online Yeshiva through CMJ Israel.

Acts of the Holy Spirit - Course Outline

The Book of Acts is known often as the Acts of the Apostles. Yet the Apostles are not the central protagonists of the Book. The Holy Spirit is mentioned more times in Acts than all of Paul's Epistles and Gospels of Matthew, Mark and John. Acts remains the sacred history of how the Holy Spirit moved the Gospel from Jerusalem to the World.

During this course we will study the Book of Acts, examining the following topics - Nature of Sacred History as the Gospel goes West, Nature of the Holy Spirit during the Second Temple Period, Nature of the Kingdom of Heaven.

We will examine the early Messianic Movement as described in Acts, their texts, languages and oral traditions. We will especially note the role of Discipleship in Jewish tradition. We will discuss the debate over boundary issues of Jewish and Gentile followers of Messiah and include the debate on the Jewishness of Luke, the author of Acts.

Texts used will include the Book of Acts, the Didache (Teachings of the Apostles), In the Shadow of the Temple by Skarsaunne, Josephus and Encyclopedia Judaica.

Course introduction:

SESSION 1 FRIDAY BEGINNING AT 7 P.M.

We begin with the Genre of Sacred History, the authorship and traditions of the Book of Acts and discuss the history of the early Messianic Movement. Texts will be provided from *In the Shadow of the Temple* by Skarsaunne.

SESSION 2 FRIDAY ENDING 9:30 P.M.

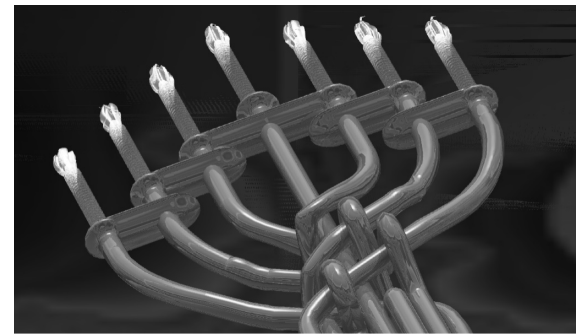
We examine the development of the Holy Spirit during the Second Temple Period in Jewish thought. We look at Acts 1 and the references to the Spirit's role in the community, including the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Texts will be provided from the Midrash and Jewish Literature.

SESSION 3 SATURDAY BEGINNING AT 2 P.M.

Acts 1 to 3 reveals that Yeshua remained on Earth for 40 days following his Resurrection teaching the Kingdom of Heaven. We discuss the importance of the Kingdom in the life of Yeshua.

SESSION 4 SATURDAY ENDING 5 P.M.

We will look in detail at Acts 2 and the Passover Exodus, examining Jewish traditions and Midrash on the exodus from Egypt. We will discuss Luke's knowledge of Jewish exegesis. Texts will be provided from Pirke de Rabbi Eliezer.



SESSION 5 SATURDAY BEGINNING AT 6 P.M.

Fellowship of the Believers, particularly the ending of Acts 2. We will continue the discussion on the practices and traditions of the early Messianic Movement. Texts will be provided from the *Didache*.

SESSION 6 SATURDAY ENDING 9 P.M.

The Acts of the Holy Spirit working through non-Apostles, looking at the sacred history of Acts 8 and discussing the reasons for its inclusion in the narrative.

SESSION 7 SUNDAY BEGINNING AT 2 P.M.

The Jerusalem Council, Acts 15, we begin with the various traditions concerning James/Ya'Akov the leader of the Messianic community in Jerusalem. We will discuss the roles and boundary issues between Jews and Gentiles in the Second Temple Period.

SESSION 8 TO 12 SUNDAY ENDING 5:30 P.M.

Acts of the Holy Spirit, during the remaining sessions we will work our way through the Book of Acts, stopping at the 40 mentions of the Holy Spirit and noting His work, what He does, how He does it. We will end with an overview of the Biblical work of the Spirit among the People of God.
